

# Moving Checklist

Use this checklist to stay organized and avoid missed steps before, during, and after your mobile home move.

## 1. Pre-Move Preparation

- Remove skirting, decks, awnings, and exterior fixtures.
- Disconnect water, gas, and electrical lines safely.
- Secure or remove furniture, appliances, and loose items inside the home.
- Inspect tires, axles, and the home's frame for needed repairs.
- Gather ownership documents, insurance papers, and permits.
- Clear the area around the home for moving trucks and equipment.
- Take photos of the home's condition before transport.

## 2. Permits and Regulations

- Contact local housing or transportation offices for permit requirements.
- Apply for moving permits directly to avoid extra service charges.
- Verify any escort or police vehicle requirements for wide loads.
- Keep copies of all permits and approvals on hand for movers.

## 3. Choosing a Mover

- Get at least three quotes from licensed mobile home movers.
- Confirm what's included (transport, setup, insurance, permits).
- Check mover licenses, insurance, and customer reviews.
- Compare cost, value, and experience before signing a contract.

## 4. Preparing the New Site

- Make sure the site is level and accessible for large vehicles.
- Confirm utility hookups for water, power, and sewage.
- Prepare foundation blocks or tie-down systems as needed.
- Clear debris or obstacles before delivery.

## 5. Moving Day Essentials

- Confirm the mover's arrival time and route.
- Keep your phone charged and all paperwork accessible.
- Double-check that all utilities are disconnected.
- Ensure the mover secures the home properly before transport.

## 6. After the Move

- Have licensed professionals reconnect utilities.
- Make sure the home is level and anchored securely.
- Inspect doors, windows, and walls for cracks or gaps.
- Check plumbing and electrical systems for leaks or faults.
- Review the mover's work before final payment.
